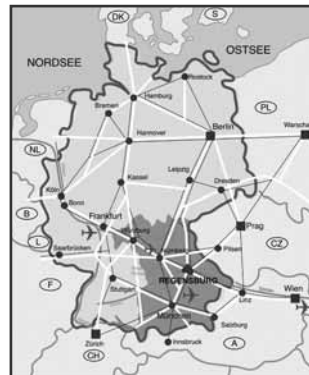

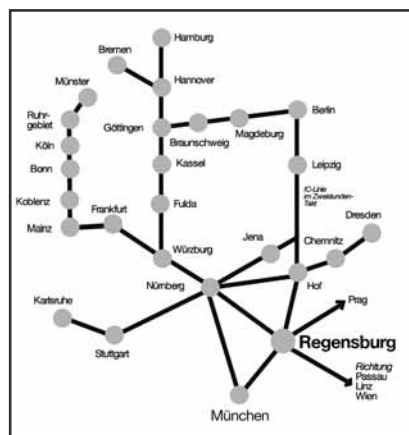

Medical service: The medical service will be placed at all competition fields.

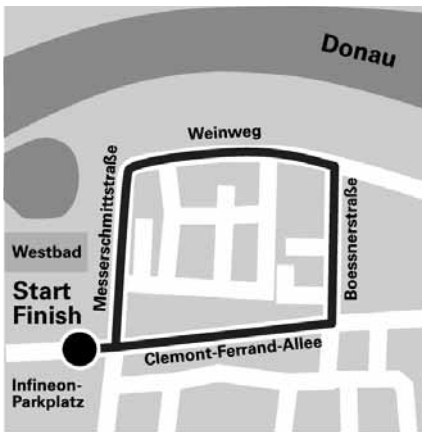

Photo service: First Foto Factory will be official photo service.

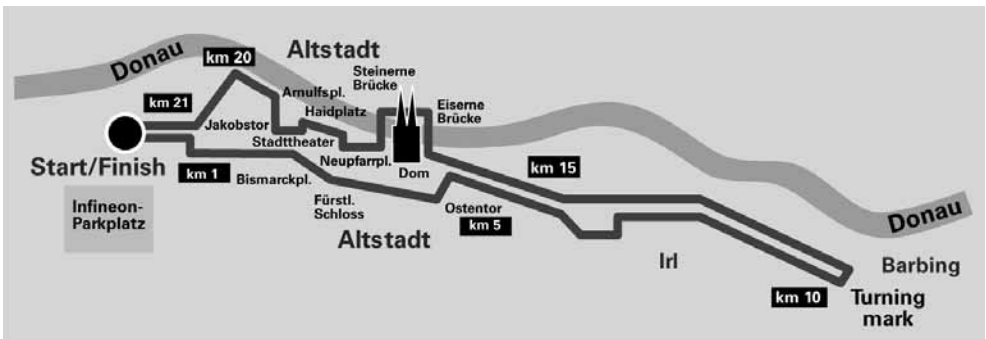
MAPS OF DIFFERENT RACES

AWARDS

Competitors will be awarded

- individually (with medal): first 3 for each 5 years age group
- for team (with medal) first 3 country-team for 10 years age group as follow
W35+40 – W45+50 – W55+60 – W 65+70 over
M35+40 – M45+50 – M55+60 – M 65+70 over
No possibility to change age group (from old to young age group)
The placings will be done with the summ of the performance of the first 3 competitor of the country in the age group.

Cross country relay

- team will be done with 3 athletes of the same 5 years age group of the same country already in the entries of the Championships.
- No possibility to change age group (from old to young age group)
- Country can present many teams but only the first will be awarded
- The entry for Cross relay will be done by the team leader between 3 pm and 6 pm of Friday 18 at TIC – Entry fee is 10 € for team
Will be awarded the first 3 team of each 5 years age group.

Timekeeping with Champion-Chip: The timekeeping will only be handled with Time Champion-Chip. Without this Chip you 'll have no timekeeping.
